Our Coffs Coast Excursion is fast approaching. It is now time to confirm final details and payment. The following will be included in this information package:

Departure/Return

Departure has been arranged to be from **Eltham Public School** on Wednesday morning, 14th of September. Departure will be at 8:00am, please ensure you are at Eltham Public School by **7:45am** to pack the coach and get settled.

Students will return to **Eltham Public School** on Friday evening, 16th of September at approximately 4:30pm. Text updates will be provided throughout the afternoon on our progress and exact arrival back at Eltham Public School.

Cost

The approximate total cost of the camp and transport is \$380. This amount is subject to change and dependent on the number of students participating in the experience. The final balance will be deducted from students' Educational Hardship Fund unless otherwise requested. Students with outstanding balances will be contacted individually.

Student Information

It is important we are aware of any special needs your child may have as soon as possible. In order that both Coffs Coast Adventure Camp and Eureka staff are aware of your child's needs, please complete the registration process by following the link below. **Please note:** the portal will say Eltham Public School as our group is listed under one name. Eureka students are part of this group. The registration process will allow you to enter any medical or dietary requirements your child may have. Information registered in the portal will only be visible to relevant staff. Children will not be able to attend the excursion without its completion. Packing

Please limit your packing to one bag/suitcase that can be managed by your child. A small day bag is also recommended for on board the coach. Students will need to pack a full lunch for the first day, including morning and afternoon tea. Packing should be done at each family's discretion; the list is a guide. Please clearly label items, as students will be responsible for their belongings.

Devices

Personal devices are not needed for the excursion. Students will not be permitted to use a device at any point during the camp. Photos will be taken by staff and shared via our closed Facebook page.

Food

A full lunch will be required for the first day of the excursion. This will need to include enough food and water for lunch, morning and afternoon tea. Once at the camp, all meals will be provided.

Money

Money is not necessary for the excursion. There will be no opportunities for shopping nor souvenirs. Any money brought by a student will be their responsibility.

Behaviour Contract

The attached behaviour contract is to be completed and returned with the permission slip. It is important that students are aware of their responsibility to be considerate and respectful to all teachers, students, camp staff and the public. It is equally important that students understand the teachers have a duty of care to everyone on the trip and if an individual's behaviour compromises the safety or enjoyment of others then their own participation in the trip will be ended. If a student's behaviour requires it, parents will be responsible for collecting the child at their own expense.
