## **First North Swimming Carnival**

## Alstonville Aquatic Centre - Tuesday 8 February 2022

Dear Parents and Carers,

Due to COVID safety measures in place for the beginning of our school year the First North Community of Small Schools Swimming Carnival will have some guidelines to follow. Please read the following information carefully.

- Purpose of Activity: First North Swimming Carnival for Zone PSSA selection.
- Destination: Alstonville Aquatic Centre, 13/15 Alston Ave, Alstonville
- Date: Tuesday 8 February 2022
- Students: Students who are turning 8 years or older in 2022.
- Staff Involved: Bill Dempster and Ronja Brown
- Transport: Private.
- Cost: \$5.50 pool entry to be paid at entry (Fitness Passport or Pool Season passes can be used)
- Any spectators wishing to attend will also be required to pay \$5.50 for entry.
- Time: Arrive at 9:30 am for first event marshalling at 9:45am. Finish at approximately 1:30pm
- **Dress Requirements:** Swimmers, towel, change of dry clothes including underwear, sunscreen, hat, water bottle. *Please come dressed ready to compete.*
- **Food/Drink:** The pool kiosk will be operating; however, we encourage students to bring their own food and drink to minimise mingling around the kiosk.
- Current Safety Guidelines: Current guidelines will require spectators to sit separately from competitors. Please follow signage on the day and do not enter the school seating area. We encourage students to leave the venue after the events they are entering. We also encourage spectators to be kept to a minimum, i.e. 1 spectator per competitor.

Successful competitors who meet qualifying times will be expected to represent the First North Community of Small Schools at the Northern Rivers PSSA Swimming Carnival on Tuesday 1 March 2022 at Lismore Memorial Baths.

If the weather is inclement an announcement will be sent to all families via text.

### Please Note:

Ribbons will be awarded to the first three place getters in each event. Medals will be awarded to age champions (Junior Girl and Boy, 11yrs Girl and Boy and Senior Girl and boy).

There are qualifying times for the zone carnival and placing in an event does not necessarily result in zone representation.

Ribbons and medals will be given to schools to disperse back at their site this year. Hopefully this will reduce mingling and parents/students staying until the end for the presentation.

<u>Individual Medley-</u> To compete in the 200m individual medley, swimmers must enter prior to the carnival by submitting a time achieved at a previous carnival, squad training session or swimming club night. **POINTS FROM THE INDIVIDUAL MEDLEY WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE POINTSCORE FOR SCHOOLS OR CHAMPIONS.** We encourage participation but this is a difficult event and we ask for schools support in encouraging only competent swimmers to participate. The fastest 4 students in each age group will represent the First North District in relay events at the zone carnival (dependent on total school numbers).
