## SENIOR CAMP 2017—EOI

At the recent P&C Meeting it was voted that the Senior Class will go once again to Canberra this year for the Senior Camp. This form is an Expression of Interest for the Camp to allow us to confirm numbers so that when we start to book activities and travel we can do so with a set price based on set numbers of students attending.

Due to the larger number of students in the Senior Class now, the arrangements and the costing of 2014 Camp don't really fit our current situation but it would be roughly between \$400 -\$500 per child from each family plus a subsidy from the P&C .

Students in Year 3 can elect not to attend the Camp (they will come to school instead) if there are concerns about being away from home for 5 nights/6 days or if the cost is too prohibitive.

A final decision will be made about the viability of going to Canberra (Camp would be early term 3 so we would still have some snow) or if we look at a different Camp for this year (Sport & Rec)
