Hello everyone

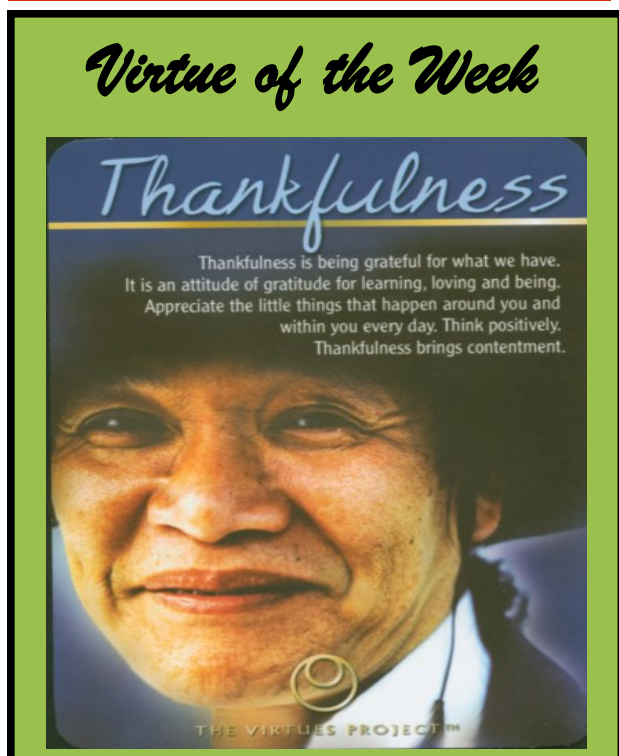

After 6 weeks of investigations, recipe designs, prototypes, problem solving, failures and success we finally got there.

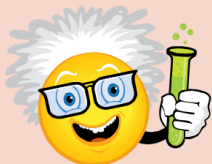
The edible mysteries were fantastic and unfortunately ran out way too soon.

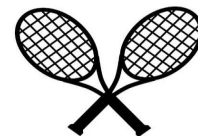


SENIOR CAMP is only 3 weeks away!
