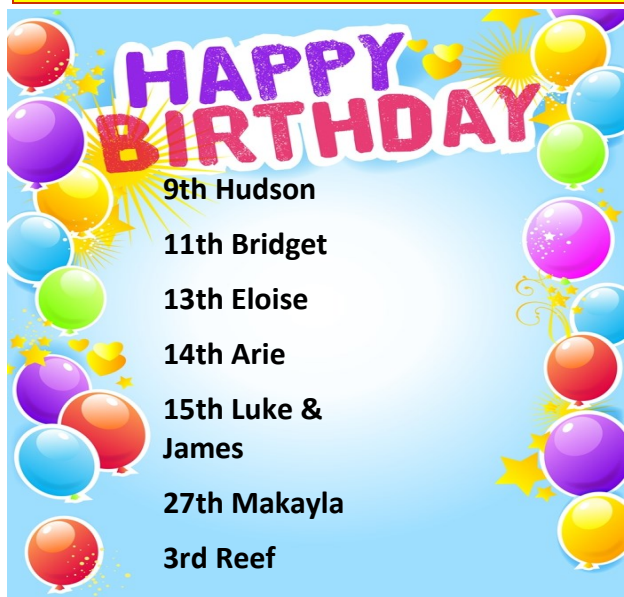

## Summer Swim Scheme

This week, all Students in Years 3—6 will be attending two days Intensive Swimming in preparation for our annual PSSA First North Swimming Carnival. Students will travel by bus to Mullum Pool on Wednesday & Thursday, leaving school at 11.30am and returning at 3pm. Cost is \$50 per child for the two days, which includes pool entry, bus travel and instructors. The aim of this is to improve lap swimming and stroke correction. Unfortunately this program has not been funded through the Sporting Schools, hence the increased cost. Please ensure students have morning tea, lunch and water provided each day as well as all clothes labelled and that they arrive at school in full uniform, with their swimmers, towel and goggles in a plastic bag. Any issues regarding cost please discuss with Mr C.

## First North Swimming Carnival

This Friday students aged 8 years and above who can swim 50 metres will be attending the FN Swimming Carnival at Lismore Pool. We will travel by bus to the pool, leaving school at 8.45am and returning before 3pm. Students will need to bring morning tea and lunch. Students will swim in their age race and can elect to swim in breast stroke & back stroke. Mr Coleman will select the relay teams.

## Waste Warriors

Last year we came 2nd place in the Byron Council Waste Warriors Challenge, receiving \$750 funding. We have used this funding to purchase a new bin system throughout the school. The new system features a large yellow mixed recycling bin, a small red landfill bin, a small green composting bin and a clear soft plastics bin. These will feature in all classrooms, staff room, offices, canteen and library. It is hoped that a long with our other waste reduction initiatives, including waste free lunches, that we can continue to lessen the impact we have on our environment.
