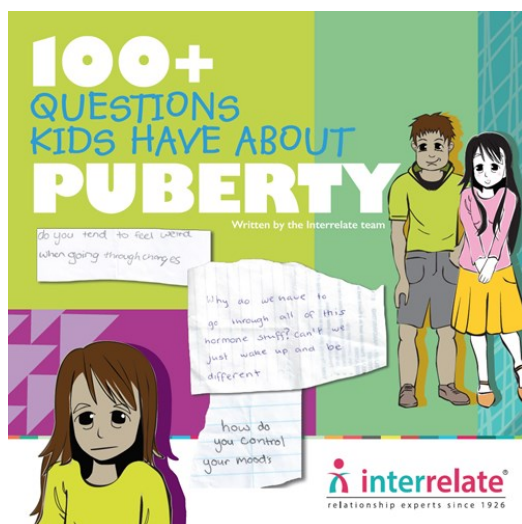


## INTERRELATE

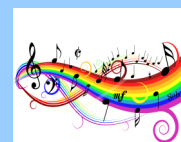
