Author Tristan Bancks will be visiting our school to speak to students about writing, reading and his life as a writer. A great opportunity to get to know the ins-and-outs of storytelling.

Hear all about Tristan's journey from Blue Mountains schoolboy to teen TV actor and presenter, to children's and teen author. Discover the books he loves to read, how he finds inspiration and how he makes a living telling stories. Along the way, have lots of laughs and gain valuable tips on using your life to inspire your own funny, gross or thrilling stories.

Tristan's latest book is Tom Weekly: My Life and Other Failed Experiments. It's a collection of fastmoving, wild and funny short stories, lists, quizzes and 'Would You Rathers', illustrated by Gus Gordon.

His latest thriller novel is The Fall, a story about Sam Garner, a kid who witnesses a crime through the rear window of his father's apartment. The person who committed the crime knows that Sam is the sole witness and comes after him. Sam must stay safe, strong and find his dad who has gone missing.
